



## IBM® Connections – Other Reports Widget

Some organizations have a Human Resources view of the reporting structure and also an alternate view. This alternate view may be project or shift based but adding this information into IBM® Connections can be worthwhile. The Other Reports widget is designed to capture these relationships within IBM® Connections. This widget can be populated either top down (i.e. Manager → Employee) or bottom up (i.e. Employee → Manager) and allows for a many to many relationship (i.e. an Employee can have many Managers and a Manager can manage many Employees).

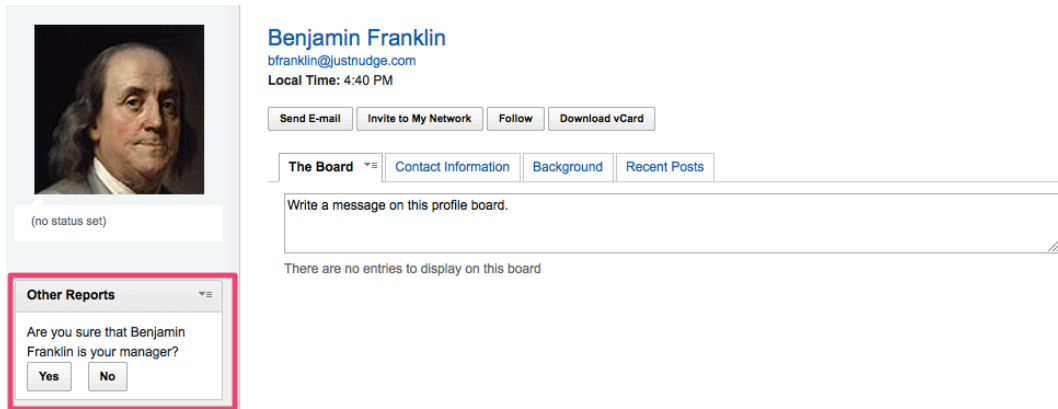
The workflow for updating an alternate manager is as follows (for this example lets assume that John Adams reports to Benjamin Franklin):

1. John Adams logs into IBM® Connections and locates Benjamin Franklin's profile.

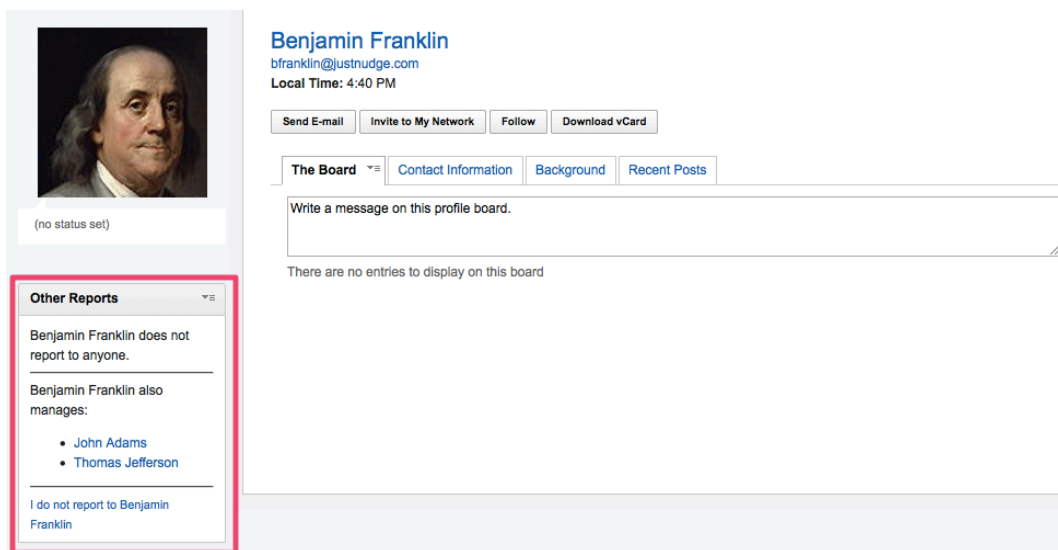

3. After clicking “Yes”, the widget is updated to show that Benjamin Franklin now manages both Thomas Jefferson and John Adams:

The widget ships with an English language only configuration by default. However, the widget is fully internationalized and custom feedback messages for an appropriate locale can be added if required.

### Look and Feel

This widget uses the standard styles used by IBM® Connections. Changes to these styles should be inherited by the widget. The following styles are used:

- lotusAction
- lotusFormButton
